Bus Expectations

1. The driver will assign the students a seat and he/she will be responsible for that seat.
2. Be on time. The bus will not wait for late riders.
3. Respectful behavior is expected at all times. Inappropriate behavior/language may result in suspension from the bus.
4. Keep hands, arms, and head and other objects inside the bus at all times.
5. Stay in your seat while the bus is in motion.
6. When crossing the road, always go at least 10 feet in front of the bus, wait for the driver's signal and look both directions before crossing. Always cross in FRONT of the bus.
7. No open food or drink allowed on the bus.
8. No alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs on the bus.
9. Matches, lighters, or any open flames could result in immediate suspension.
