

Continuation of Remote Learning Resolution

Somers School District #29 hereby resolves to continue with our District's previously approved remote learning plan for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. Teachers and support staff will continue to communicate with families and students to meet individual needs including: offsite learning instruction and structure; school meals, consistent with the approved summer food service program; services for students with disability; and other services customarily provided to students.

Building administrators may work collaboratively with staff and determine if a student should be invited for a 1:1 check for academic and/or social/emotional support, consistent with Governor Bullock's April 22, 2020 Directive implementing Executive Orders 2-2020 and 3-2020 and guidance for the phased reopening of Montana.

Furthermore, the last day of school for students will remain Friday, June 5. However, as we normally would toward the end of the school year, teachers will conclude the majority of instruction of new content with students on Friday, May 29. The remaining instructional days will be used for continuing to serve students through: meeting individual student instructional needs as determined necessary by teachers; student completion of missing assignments for 4th quarter; discussions regarding student performance and needs; determining students' proficiencies and how to address student needs in the future; teacher collaboration to meet student needs; cleaning out lockers/cubbies/desks; student/parent pick-up of student items; and return of textbooks, library books, Chromebooks, and other items.
